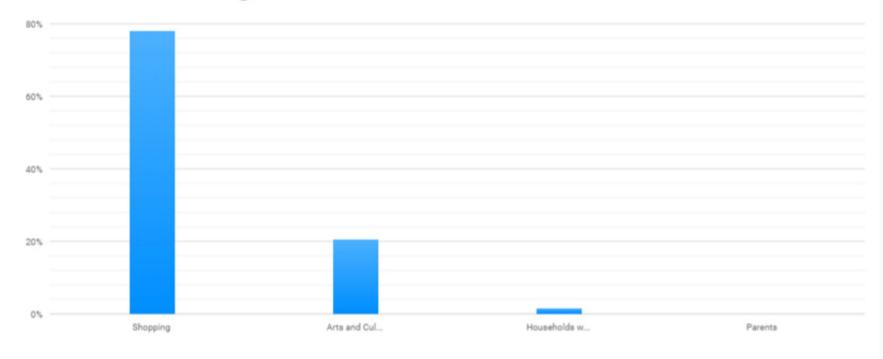

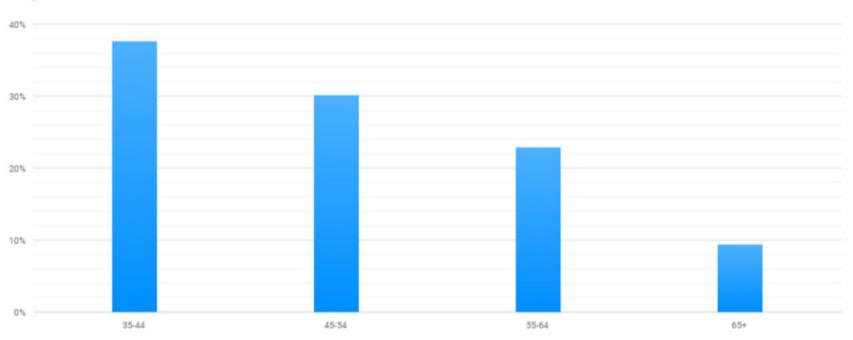

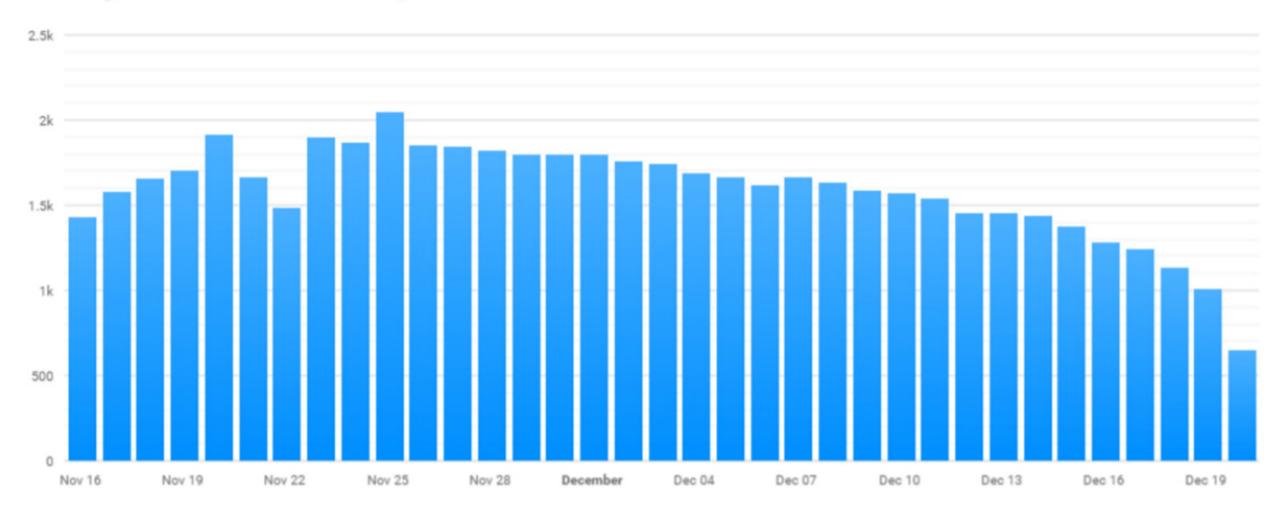
Behavioural Segments Breakdown

Daily Trend for Impressions

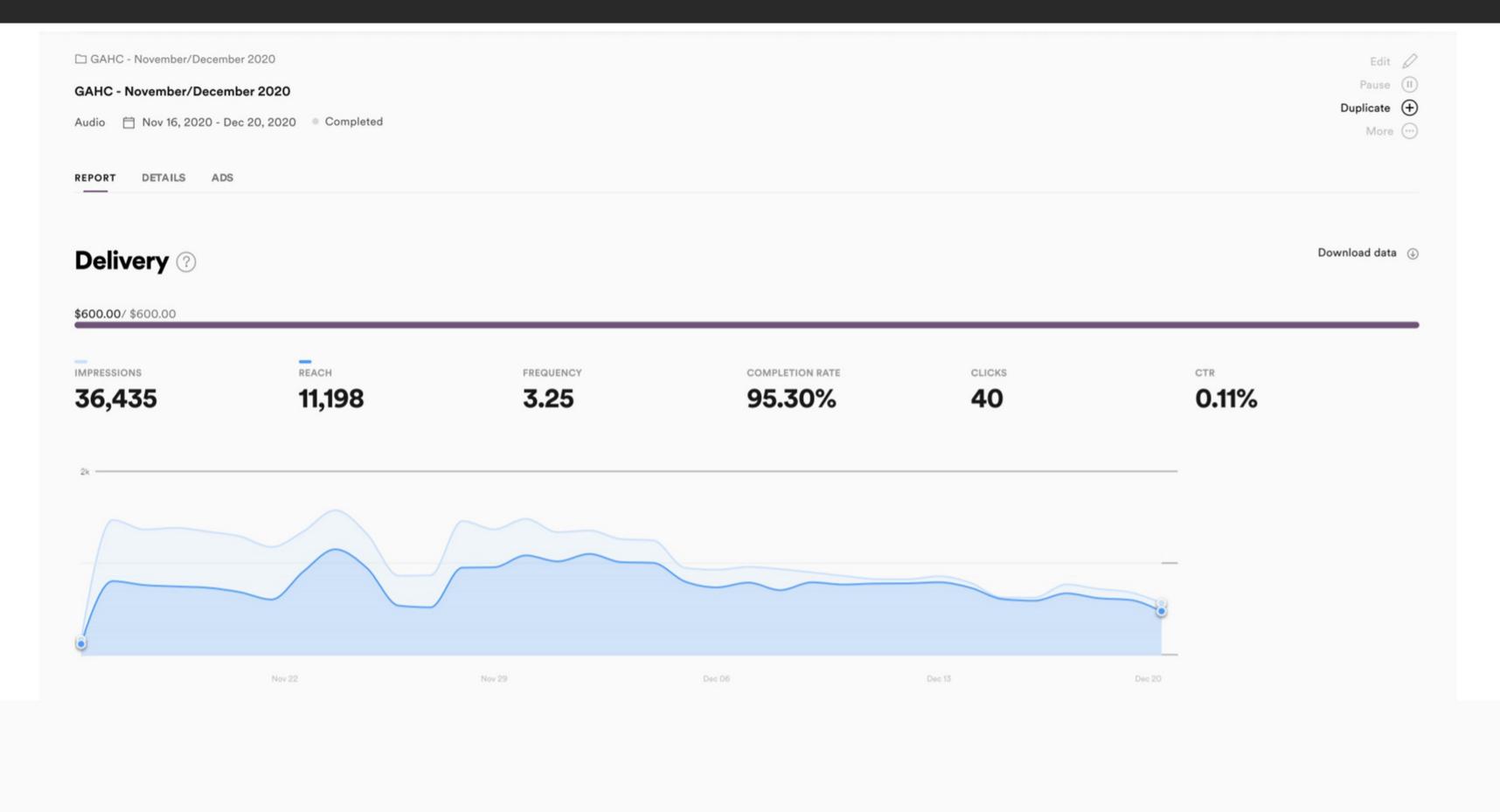

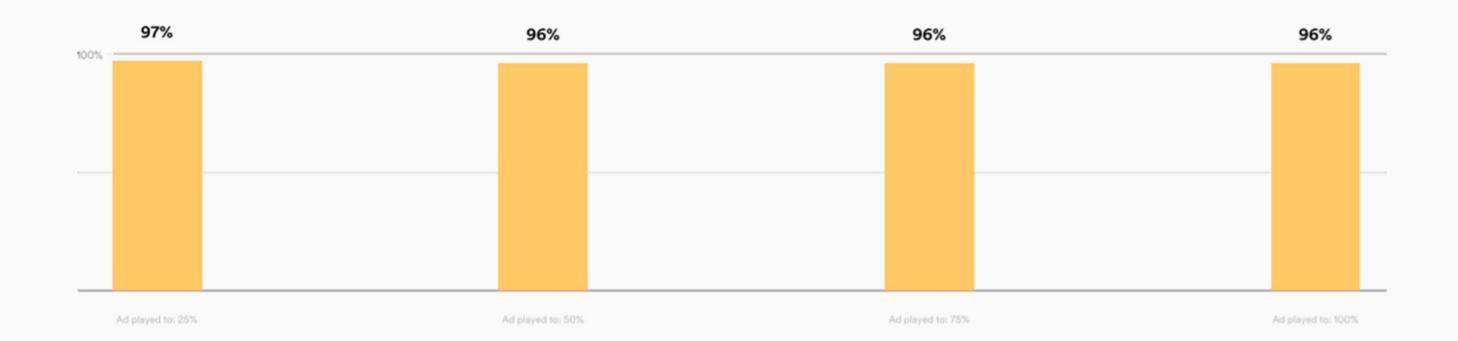

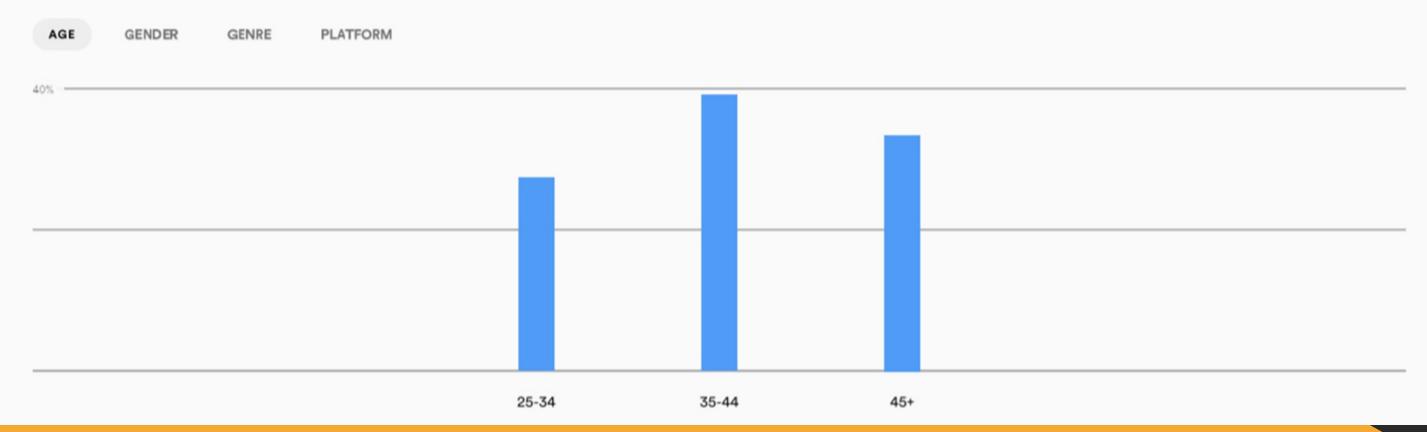
