Collection Management Bootcamp 2021 Summer Program Application German American Heritage Center & Museum

Description:

The German American Heritage Center & Museum is excited to offer a Collection Management Bootcamp. This week long, hands-on program will give students experience working in all facets of museum collection management.

Learning Objective:

This program will offer a hands-on educational approach to learning the skills necessary to care for a museum collection. Lead by museum professionals and educators, students will complete a multitude of projects to build competence. A portfolio and resume workshop will complete the program.

Eligibility:

This program is intended for undergraduate and graduate students in the following disciplines: History, Anthropology, Art History, German, Non-Profit Management, Design, Museum Studies, or a related field. Interns are selected by an application and review process, which may include an interview.

Commitment:

This week long program will run from Monday, July 12th to Friday July 16th. Students are expected to participate in the program each day from 9am to 4pm.

Academic Credit:

Students will receive a certificate of completion at the end of this program. This program may qualify for academic credit with your university. If students are interested in gaining credit for this program, they must speak with their academic advisor.

Cost:

The cost of attendance for this program is \$1000 dollars. This covers the cost of the curriculum, materials, and educators. To enable students from all backgrounds to participate in this program, scholarships are available. Please denote your interest in financial support on the application form.
