
Access Zoom

- If you have the Zoom app on your computer it will ask to "Open Zoom.us"
- This is the best way to access Zoom on a computer or smartphone.
- If you do not have the app downloaded, you can click the blue "Launch Meeting" button



Access Zoom


- A Zoom window will open and you will be asked to enter your name and email address. Your name will appear in the meeting as you type it here.
- Click "Register and Join"


